Little Brown Nymph

Hook: Dai-Riki 060 10 - 18
Thread: Brown UNI-Thread 8/0
Tail: Brown Pheasant tail
Rib: Fine gold wire
Body: Super fine brown dubbing
Thorax: Brown Pheasant tail
Legs: Brown Pheasant tail

Hand tied By: Deward Yocum



1. Catch your hook in the vise.



2. Start your thread about 1/3 down the hook shank.



3. Cut about 5 or 6 Pheasant tail tips and tie in on top of the hook shank, stop in front of the barb.



4. Cut a piece of fine gold wire and tie in on the near side of the hook shank.



5. Wrap your thread back to the front of the barb and apply some dubbing to your thread.



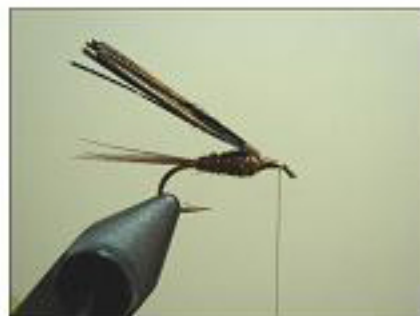
6. Wrap your thread with dubbing forward over 2/3 of the hook shank, forming a cone shape.



7. Wrap your fine gold wire forward to the front of the body and wrap two or three turns of thread to hold in place.



8. Cut off the wire tag and tie in about 20 or so Pheasant tail tips on top of the hook shank.



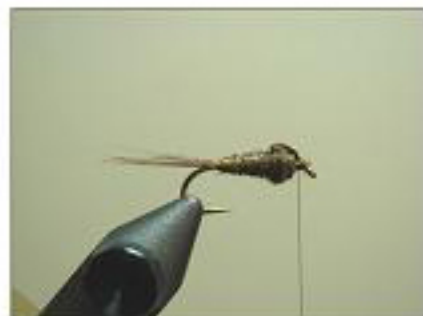
9. Cut off the Pheasant tail tag ends and apply some dubbing to your thread.



10. Wrap your thread with dubbing back and over the body and Pheasant tail to create a thorax.



11. Pull the Pheasant tail over the thorax and wrap two or three turns of thread to hold in place.



12. Cut the Pheasant tail tag ends and make two or three locking turns of thread.



13. Turn your fly up side down and take 20 or so Pheasant tail tips and tie in just in front of the thorax.



14. Now pull on the tag end of the Pheasant tail till they are about even with the hook gap.



15. Whip finish the head and apply head cement.



Your done! Now get out there and do some fishing.....
