Where: Seven Springs Fish Hatchery. Directions: From Highway 4 north of Jemez Springs, turn west onto State Road 126 past Fenton Lake to approximately mile marker 26. Turn right onto Forest Road 314 into Seven Springs State Fish Hatchery. (From Cuba, take State Road 126 east. Turn left onto Forest Road 314 into Seven Springs State Fish Hatchery.) Follow the signs.

How: Registration will take place on the day of the event at the Hatchery.
There is no need to pre-register your children for the event.

Who: Hosted by New Mexico Department of Game & Fish, Santa Fe National Forest, U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service, New Mexico Trout, Jemez Valley businesses, and others.
